I love the classic beauties of patchwork; Churn Dash, Ohio Star, Album Block and for me, when using these angular blocks there's no better finish than the right border.

For this class I will show and demonstrate ideas for borders and also show you several of my own quilts, large and small, that I've finished with borders. I will give you patterns for six borders.



The quilt we will work on in class is my Red Ribbon Quilt using a stripe. It is made with nine 9" Album blocks and the Ribbon Border, as shown in the photo. Using the colors of your choice, you will complete one album block and make at least two corners of the Ribbon Border. You will go home with the confidence to complete your quilt, using the techniques you'll learn in class.

Upon registration I will send you a supplies list along with a close-up photo of my quilt so you can see how I used a stripe in my pattern.
