

Quick Curve Pumpkin Table Runner

(Using the Crazy Eights Pillow pattern found in the book "Contemporary Curved Quilts")

Fabric Requirements

4 assorted oranges – 10" x 16" (or fat quarters)
1 orange (for wide pumpkin) – 10" x 18" (or fat quarter)
Background fabric – ¾ yard
Green – 2 ½" x 9"
2" Binding – 9" x WOF

Class Supply List

- Quick Curve Ruler
- "Contemporary Curved Quilts" Book by Sew Kind of Wonderful
- Sewing machine
- Rotary Cutter and Mat
- Any other supplies you would use for piecing a quilt

****Please cut out the fabrics (as described below) before the class. DO NOT cut out the curves, as we will be learning to do this in the class. Thanks.****

Cutting Instructions

From each of the 4 orange fabrics:

Cut 1 piece 8" x 10" (pumpkin)

Cut 2 pieces 2 ¾" x 10" (pumpkin)

From remaining orange fabric:

Cut 1 square 10" x 10" (wide pumpkin)

Cut 2 pieces 2 ¾" x 10" (pumpkin)

From green fabric:

Cut 5 pieces 2 ½" x 1 ¾" (stem)

From Back ground fabric:

Cut 10 pieces 3 ½" x 10" (background next to pumpkin)

Cut 8 pieces 2 ½" x 4" (background next to stem on thin pumpkins)

Cut 2 pieces 2 ½" x 5 1/8" (background next to stem on fat pumpkins)

Cut 4 pieces 1 ½" x 11 ½" (sashing between pumpkins)

Cut 2 pieces 3" x 11 ½" (outer side boarders)

Cut 3 pieces 3" x WOF (outer top boarders)
